The design was adapted from the 1d."Universal" with the words "Dominion of" added at the top. The Plates were made by Perkins, Bacon & Co., and printed by the Government Printer in sheets of 240 (10 horizontal rows of 24) and in booklets.

From 1909 until 1924-5 the stamps appeared on paper generally known as "De La Rue", but at that date a series of provisional or experimental papers was used until the paper known as "Cowan" became established as the regular paper for this stamp.

Stamps in booklets were issued from 1910 both with and without advertisements on the selvedges.
